4 This Act may be cited as the "Love Lives On Act5 of 2025".

1	SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF ENTITLEMENT TO VETERANS
2	DEPENDENCY AND INDEMNITY COMPENSA-
3	TION FOR SURVIVING SPOUSES WHO RE-
4	MARRY.
5	Section 103(d) of title 38, United States Code, is
6	amended—
7	(1) in paragraph $(2)(B)$ —
8	(A) by inserting "(i)" before "The remar-
9	riage'';
10	(B) in clause (i), as designated by subpara-
11	graph (A), by striking "Notwithstanding the
12	previous sentence" and inserting the following:
13	"(ii) Notwithstanding clause (i)"; and
14	(C) by adding at the end the following new
15	clause:
16	"(iii) Notwithstanding clause (ii), the remarriage of
17	a surviving spouse shall not bar the furnishing of benefits
18	under section 1311 or 1562 of this title to the surviving
19	spouse of a veteran."; and
20	(2) in paragraph (5) —
21	(A) by striking subparagraph (A); and
22	(B) by renumbering subparagraphs (B)
23	through (E) as subparagraphs (A) through (D),

4	Section 1450(b)(2) of title 10, United States Code,
5	is amended—
6	(1) by striking "An annuity" and inserting the
7	following:
8	"(A) IN GENERAL.—(A) Subject to sub-
9	paragraph (B), an annuity''; and
10	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
11	paragraph:
12	"(B) TREATMENT OF SURVIVORS OF MEM-
13	BERS WHO DIE ON ACTIVE DUTY.—The Sec-
14	retary may not terminate payment of an annu-
15	ity for a surviving spouse described in subpara-
16	graph (A) or (B) of section $1448(d)(1)$ solely
17	because that surviving spouse remarries. In the
18	case of a surviving spouse who remarried before
19	reaching age 55 and before the date of the en-
20	actment of Love Lives On Act of 2025, the Sec-
21	retary shall resume payment of the annuity to
22	that surviving spouse—
23	"(i) except as provided by clause (ii),
24	for each month that begins on or after the
25	date that is one year after such date of en-
26	actment; or

13	Section 1072(2) of title 10, United States Code, is
14	amended—
15	(1) in subparagraph (H), by striking "; and"
16	and inserting a semicolon;
17	(2) in subparagraph $(I)(v)$, by striking the pe-
18	riod at the end and inserting "; and"; and
19	(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
20	paragraph:
21	"(J) a remarried widow or widower whose
22	subsequent marriage has ended due to death,
23	divorce, or annulment.".
